English	Japanese	Romaji
Expensive	たかい	takai
Cheap	やすい	yasui
Delicious / yum	おいしい	oishii
Yuck	まずい	mazui
Sweet	あまい	amai
Sour	すっぱい	suppai
Spicy	からい	karai
Pretty / looks good	きれい	kirei

When we describe something, we use the sentence pattern - Adjective + です。

Adding to the end of the sentence changes it into a question.

Adding to the end of the sentences, adds 'isn't it' to the statement.

EXPENSIVE

たかい です。

Takai desu.

It's expensive

たかい ですか。

Takai desuka.

Is it expensive?

たかい ですね。

Takai desune.

It's expensive, isn't it?
